# Ontario Investment and Trade Centre

## A focal point for international collaboration

The Centre is a focal point for Ontario's collaborative, province-wide approach to promoting international trade, foreign direct investment and business immigration. It's also a hub for the training and knowledge development of Ontario exporters and economic development stakeholders.

## Technology to accelerate discussion and decision-making

Throughout the facility, advanced technology puts information at your finger tips. The boardrooms have web, multimedia, video and teleconferencing capabilities with plasma screens and touch-screen technology. There are interactive pen displays that allow you to write notes, create images and print or save to a file. A number of rooms are equipped with hearing assist systems.

More high-performance technologies are being added. The GIS (Geographic Information System) technology now in development will enable the layering of information on-screen – land and labour availability, transportation and training capacities, and much, much more – so investment site options can be more easily evaluated.

**A reflection of Ontario** The design marries advanced technology with flowing lines and natural materials that accentuate Ontario's rugged beauty – limestone, maple and cherry woods, steel and copper. The Centre was also built for LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification – the construction industry's internationally recognized standard for environmental sustainability and energy efficiency.

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## The Galleria

Ideal for receptions, media announcements and gatherings of up to 80 people, the Galleria offers the latest in presentation technologies within an environment that speaks to Ontario's past and future – precision-milled stainless steel entrance door frames, sycamore ceiling inserts designed to resemble the ribs of a canoe, feature walls of copper and limestone, Canadian maple hardwood floors and Canadian cherry millwork – all wrapped in a spectacular view of the downtown skyline.



## Main Theatre & Seminar Room

For large-scale presentations, the 63-seat Main Theatre and the 75-seat large Seminar Room offer a broad range of technologies – from a rear projection system with double-width split screen to wireless microphones and translation capabilities – that can help participants absorb information more easily.

Different-sized boardrooms can provide the facilities needed for large project briefings, small team meetings or video conferences involving up to eight locations worldwide.

All four boardrooms have state-of-the-art technology for teleconferencing, video-conferencing, web access and multimedia presentations using plasma displays and touch screen technology.

Each of the boardrooms features cherry wood wainscoting. The acoustic ceiling tiles are made from recycled material, as they are throughout the Centre, and the carpet tiles are from an Ontario-based supplier.
